In 1990, two-thirds of newly diagnosed prostate cancers were Stage I or II (clinically localized). Slightly more than 10 percent were Stage III (regional), while about 20 percent were Stage IV (metastatic).

Treatment Options. If you've been diagnosed with prostate cancer, the options for your individual case will vary based on biopsy results. Treatment options will then be based on your age, the stage and grade of the cancer, your risk factors, and your personal choice on how to proceed. Some cases of prostate cancer are so slow-growing that immediate treatment isn't necessary.

Finding the best treatment for prostate cancer. For example, a urologist typically specializes in surgery for prostate cancer, while a radiologist specializes in radiation therapy.
